

FIRE REPORTING PROCESS

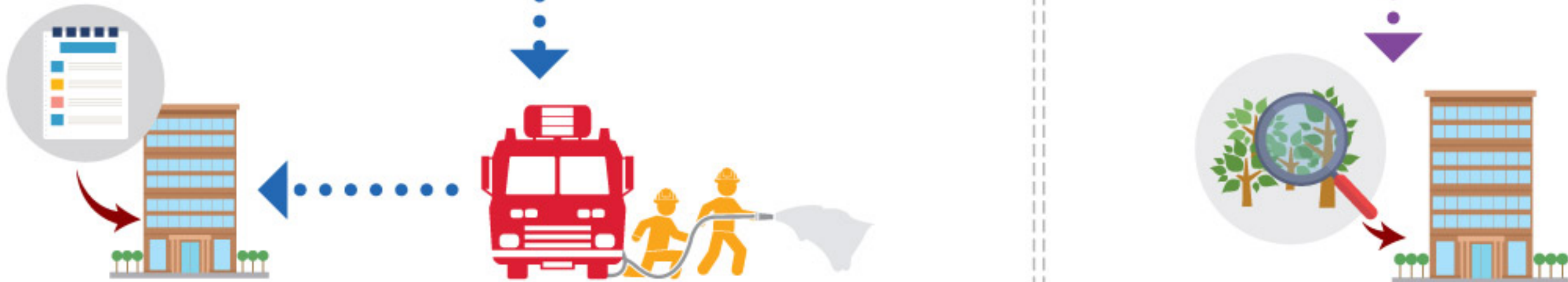


Head Office (HO) collects information on hotspots from different sources

- Ministry of Forestry
- Meteorology, Climatology and Geophysics Agency (BMKG)
- NASA (VIIRS satellite)
- NOAA satellite

Hotspots within or surrounding our concessions are immediately flagged to the operation units on the ground

Operation units have 48 hours to provide feedback on whether a fire has really occurred, and if the concession is affected



Post-fire investigations will take place and be reported back to HO

In the case of a fire, operation units quickly mobilise firefighting teams. They file an incident report based on fixed guidelines and submit it to stakeholders such as the regional police and environment agencies

In the case of a false alarm, the team will have to prove that there has not been a fire, and report it back to HO



HO compiles a weekly report of occurrences and uploads it onto our Sustainability Dashboard
